

CREATING YOUR SHAWL

Supplies:

- **1 7/8 yards of polyester/gabardine material (or any material that hangs well) 60” wide**
- **1 spool of fringe or 2 ½ - 3 yards of chainette “pre-cut fringe”**
- **Satin cloth used for creating designs (optional)**
- **Fringing needle (see picture)**
- **Sewing machine, thread, scissors, measuring tape, pins, iron, and Wonder Under (optional)**



Step One:

- Hem all four sides of fabric using sewing machine



Step Two:

- Apply fringe 2 pieces (28" long) through eye of needle, poke material & pull through, loop & tie knot (approx. thumb width apart), repeat fringe around all 4 sides



Step Three: (Optional)

- Sew applique on 1 side of folded shawl, use satin cloth to create designs. You may hand cut & stitch patterns or use Wonder Under (follow instructions in package)
