RESOLUTION 10- 13

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian Tribe (P.L. 101-484) whose business affairs are conducted by the Ponca Tribal Council as defined in the Constitution approved July 22nd, 1994 by the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to the Constitution of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska, the Ponca Tribal Council exercises legislative powers to enact and promulgate resolutions and ordinances subject to all express restrictions upon such powers contained in the constitution; and

WHEREAS: The Fred LeRoy Health and Wellness Center's overall function is to provide high quality and comprehensive dental and medical care to all federally recognized tribal members; and

WHEREAS: The Fred LeRoy Health and Wellness Center in collaboration with the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska Special Diabetes Program for Indians will provide funding for a Contractual Podiatrist/Foot Surgeon, Dr. Kham Vay Ung who will provide podiatry services at the clinic; and


WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribal Council has been informed of the need for a podiatry clinic to be offered to all federally recognized tribal members.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that that Ponca Tribe of Nebraska Tribal Council has been informed of the need for a podiatry clinic and hereby approves the plans for establishing a podiatry clinic with funding from Indian Health Services and the Special Diabetes Program for Indians.


CERTIFICATION
