RESOLUTION 10- 14

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian Tribe (P.L. 101-484) whose business affairs are conducted by the Ponca Tribal Council as defined in the Constitution approved July 22, 1994 by the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to the Constitution of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska, the Ponca Tribal Council exercises legislative powers to enact and promulgate resolutions and ordinances subject to all express restrictions upon such powers contained in the constitution; and

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska Behavioral Health Program's overall function is to assist individuals and families to attain and maintain a lifestyle that is free from the effects of chemical abuse and dependency; and

WHEREAS: This is accomplished by utilizing a comprehensive approach that focuses on the mental, emotional, physical, spiritual, social, cultural and family aspects of human development. The program also promotes abstinence and personal growth; and

WHEREAS: The Behavioral Health Program has developed policy and procedures for the Behavioral Health Program including Mental Health Counseling, Drug and Alcohol Counseling and Youth Prevention Program for the State of Iowa; and


WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribal Council has been provided a synopsis of the proposed policies and procedures for their review.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska Tribal Council hereby approves the PTON Behavioral Health Policy and Procedure Manual for the State of Iowa.
