RESOLUTION 10-21

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian Tribe (P.L. 101-484) whose business affairs are conducted by the Ponca Tribal Council as defined in the Constitution approved July 22, 1994 by the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to the Constitution of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska, the Ponca Tribal Council shall exercise legislative powers to enact and promulgate resolutions and ordinances subject to all expenses restrictions upon such powers contained in constitution; and

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribal Council has reviewed the proposed amendments to the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska Law & Order Code Title V – Landlord/Tenant & Housing Code, and Title XI – Housing Ordinance; and

WHEREAS: The Law & Order Code was placed on the April 5, 2010 and April 24, 2010 tribal council agendas for first and second readings respectively to allow comments from the public. A notice of intent to adopt this amended Law & Order Code was mailed to all tribal members ages 18 and older 10 days prior to any final action. It was also published on the Ponca Tribal website and posted at all Ponca Tribal offices.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Ponca Tribal Council approves the amendments to the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska Law & Order Code Title V – Landlord/Tenant & Housing Code, and Title XI – Housing Ordinance.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these amendments shall take effect immediately.
