RESOLUTION 10-22

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian Tribe (P.L. 101-484) whose business affairs are conducted by the Ponca Tribal Council as defined in the Constitution approved July 22, 1994 by the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to the Constitution of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska, the Ponca Tribal Council shall exercise legislative powers to enact and promulgate resolutions and ordinances subject to all express restrictions upon such powers contained in constitution; and

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska supports the revised and updated Northern Ponca Housing Authority's Tenant Housing Policies and Procedures; and

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska by and through its legislative authority hereby promulgates the following Northern Ponca Housing Authority policies in their entirety:




