WHEREAS: Pursuant to the Constitution of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska the Ponca Tribal Council exercises legislative powers to enact and promulgate resolutions and ordinances subject to all express restrictions upon such power contained in the constitution; and

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska recognizes information technology as a vital part of its infrastructure, and is dedicated to expanding services and programs throughout the service delivery area.


WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska's supports the IT Committee's role and responsibility within the Tribal Affairs structure.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ponca Tribal Council recognizes the IT Committee as a standing committee.
