Resolution 09-31

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian Tribe (P.L. 101-484) whose business affairs are conducted by the Ponca Tribal Council as defined in the Constitution approved July 22, 1994 by the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to the Constitution of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska the Ponca Tribal Council exercises legislative powers to enact and promulgate resolutions and ordinances subject to all express restrictions upon such power contained in the constitution; and


WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska seeks to enhance its Health Promotion and Disease Prevention efforts targeting Ponca Youth and other Native Youth participating in Circle of Youth and other Tribal after school programming in Niobrara, Norfolk, Omaha and Lincoln, NE and Sioux City, IA.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ponca Tribal Council supports the grant application to the Indian Health Services, for Health Promotion and Disease Prevention for the amount of \$100,000.00 for Year One with the continuation of equal funding for years two and three.
