RESOLUTION 09-35

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian Tribe (P.L. 101-484) whose business affairs are conducted by the Ponca Tribal Council as defined in the Constitution approved July 22, 1994 by the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to the Constitution of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska, the Ponca Tribal Council shall exercise legislative powers to enact and promulgate resolutions and ordinances subject to all expenses restrictions upon such powers contained in constitution; and


WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska will complete their planning process and purchase the Action Strategy Plan Management System to establish and manage the Integrated Resource Management Plan for the Ponca Tribe.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska requests \$3,800 for Bureau of Indian Affairs budget in regards to the Planning and management of our BIA programs.
