RESOLUTION 09- 41

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian Tribe (P.L. 101-484) whose business affairs are conducted by the Ponca Tribal Council as defined in the Constitution approved July 22, 1994, by the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to the Constitution of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska the Ponca Tribal Council exercises legislative powers to enact and promulgate resolutions and ordinances subject to all express restrictions upon such powers contained in the Constitution; and

WHEREAS: The Johnson O'Malley Program is a program designed for Native American children from the age of three years through grade twelve who have either ¼ degree Indian blood or proof that they are a member of a federally recognized Indian Tribe.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ponca Tribal Council supports the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska to contract the Johnson O'Malley Program for the period beginning October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska forward this Resolution to the Bureau of Indian Affairs Education Department.
