RESOLUTION 09-46

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian Tribe (P.L. 101-484) whose business affairs are conducted by the Ponca Tribal Council as defined in the Constitution approved July 22, 1994 by the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to the Constitution of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska, the Ponca Tribal Council shall exercise legislative powers to enact and promulgate resolutions and ordinances subject to all expenses restrictions upon such powers contained in constitution; and

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska's IRR TIP identifies Transportation Planning as a priority; and


WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska has identified the need for: 1) Expanding inventory to include connecting roads and 2) development of the Ponca owned roads and 3) need to update the TIP to best meet the upcoming year's needs.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska Tribal Council authorizes the Division of Transportation, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Great Plains Region to allocate any available 2% Planning funding to support the hiring of a Transportation Planner in accordance to the approved Ponca Tribe of Nebraska Transportation Planner Position Description.
