**RESOLUTION 09- 52.**

**WHEREAS:** The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian Tribe (P.L. 101-484) whose business affairs are conducted by the Ponca Tribal Council as defined in the Constitution approved July 22, 1994 by the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Indian Affairs; and

**WHEREAS:** Pursuant to the Constitution of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska, the Ponca Tribal Council shall exercise legislative powers to enact and promulgate resolutions and ordinances subject to all expenses restrictions upon such powers contained in constitution; and

**WHEREAS:** The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska support and works to provide much needed Social Services, including services and assistance for victim of domestic violence and their dependent, and its members; and

**WHEREAS:** The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska has the authority to submit an application on behalf of its Tribal membership and to administer programs and activities funded under the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services Domestic Violence Grant program; and


**WHEREAS:** The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska assures that funds awarded through this grant will be used to provide services and assistance to victims of family violence; and will comply with applicable reporting requirements and the general administrative requirements of the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Service Grant program.


