

For 2017, The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska had 2 properties assessed underneath CERCLA 128(a). The first property, KX-002, is located just north of the Niobrara headquarters buildings. After the Phase II Targeted Brownfield Assessment, it was found that the area has an increased level of Arsenic present in the soil. Currently the property is being used as storage unit, and there is no restriction for use in that capacity. It has been advised, that before any new constructions occur, to remediate the soil. The second property that was assessed was KX-004. Currently KX-004 is agriculture land mainly used as buffalo pasture. There were no chemical hazardous contaminated found on the property and it has been cleared for continued use as pasture land.

Our main goal for 2018 is continued development of KX-002. Further testing has been confirmed for later in the year. After the results have been received a clean-up plan will be proposed.
