RESOLUTION 18- 44

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian Tribe (P.L. 101-484) whose business affairs are conducted by the Ponca Tribal Council as defined in the Constitution approved July 22, 1994 by the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to the Constitution of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska and the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska Law & Order Code, the Ponca Tribal Council exercises legislative powers to enact and promulgate resolutions and ordinances subject to all express restrictions upon such powers contained in the Constitution; and

WHEREAS: The Tribe has the authority to submit an application on behalf of the Native American individuals in the Tribe and to administer programs and activities under this program; and


WHEREAS: The purpose of the Maternal and Child Health contract is to improve the health of Nebraska's Native American mothers, infants, children (including children with special health care needs), and adolescents. Specific activities are identified in the plan of activities as set forth in the 2018 Work Plan.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED That the Ponca Tribal Council approves the contract with the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health Lifespan Health Services Unit for the period of April 1, 2018 through March 31, 2019.
