WHEREAS: The National Indian Health Board Infection Control Program grant's purpose is to institute infection control precautions and preventive measures to protect healthcare workers from exposure to and infection with infectious diseases such as SARS-CoV-2. This grant aims to assist Tribes with developing an infection control program or help implement infection control education and training activities for all Tribal healthcare workers.
